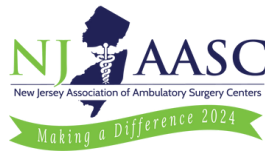

2023 - 2024

To our NJAASC members:

Firstly, thank you for your support and engagement toward the New Jersey Association of Ambulatory Surgery Centers, NJAASC. Here in New Jersey and around the country, ASCs have been faced with a shortage of staff and anesthesia. This, in turn, has impacted procedure scheduling, staffing and pay structure stress, and the challenge of keeping up with the demands for patients. NJAASC provided a survey in late 2023 to its members to analyze how these concerns are impacting operations for ASCs in the state.

Enclosed are graphs and briefings showing the findings from the Anesthesia & Staffing Shortage Survey 2023-2024. The survey opened November 27, 2023, and closed March 1, 2024. Total respondents included 96 individual facilities across 19 of 21 counties in the state. The survey asked 15 total questions relevant to the identity of the ASC reporting and the impacts of the shortages on their unique facility.

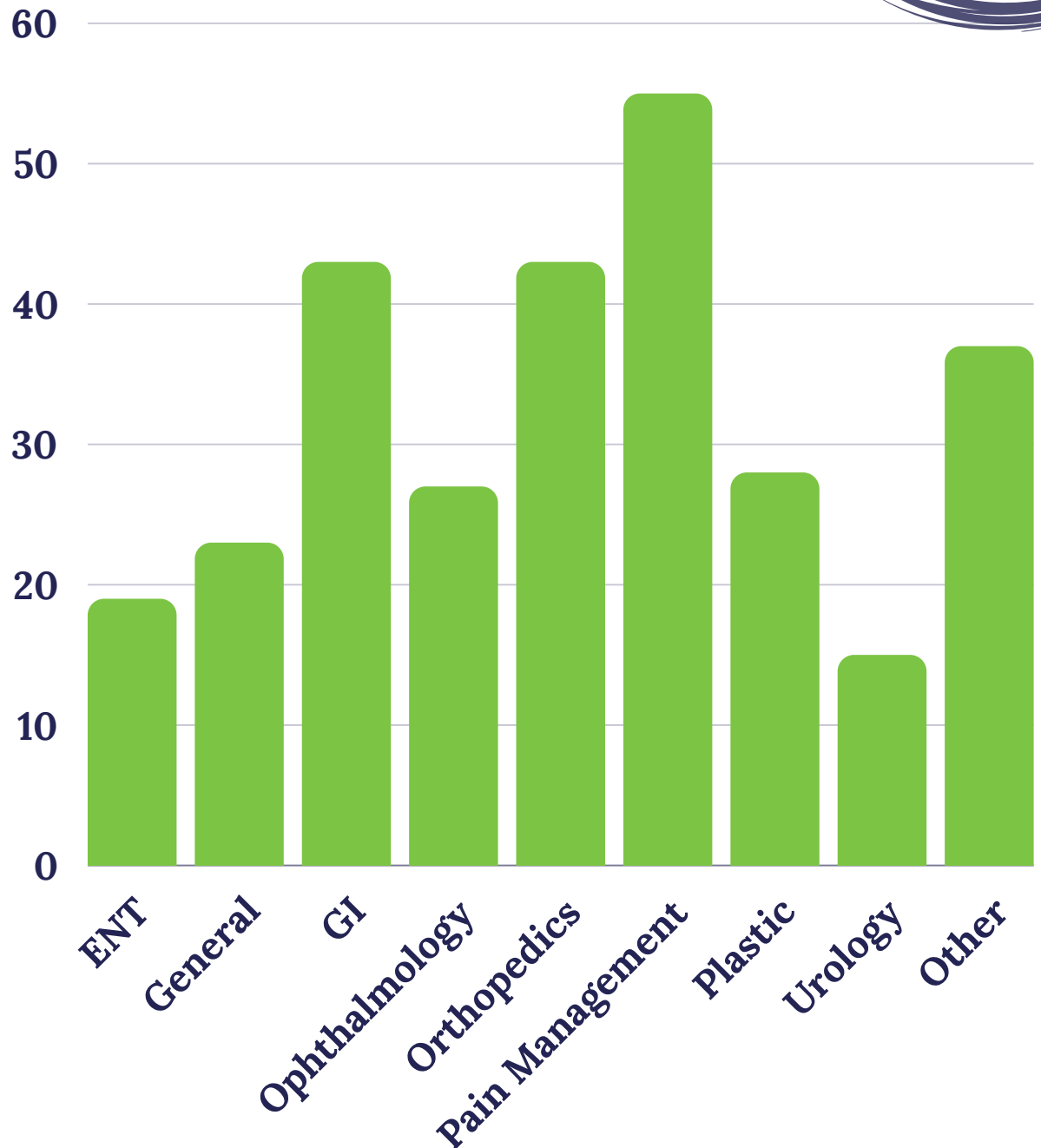

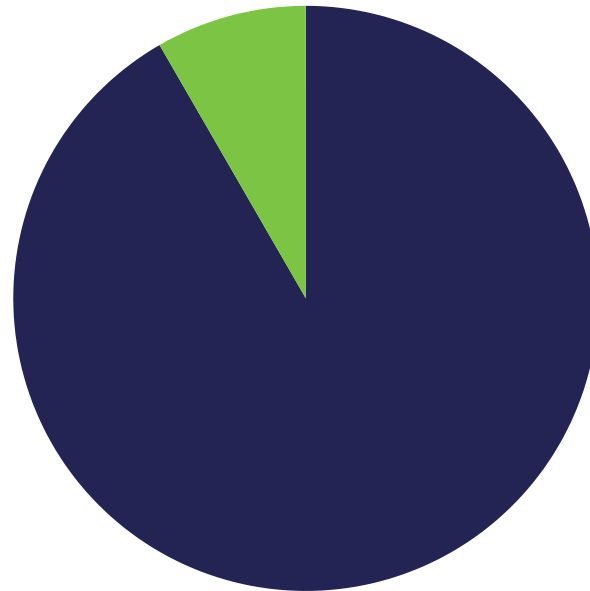

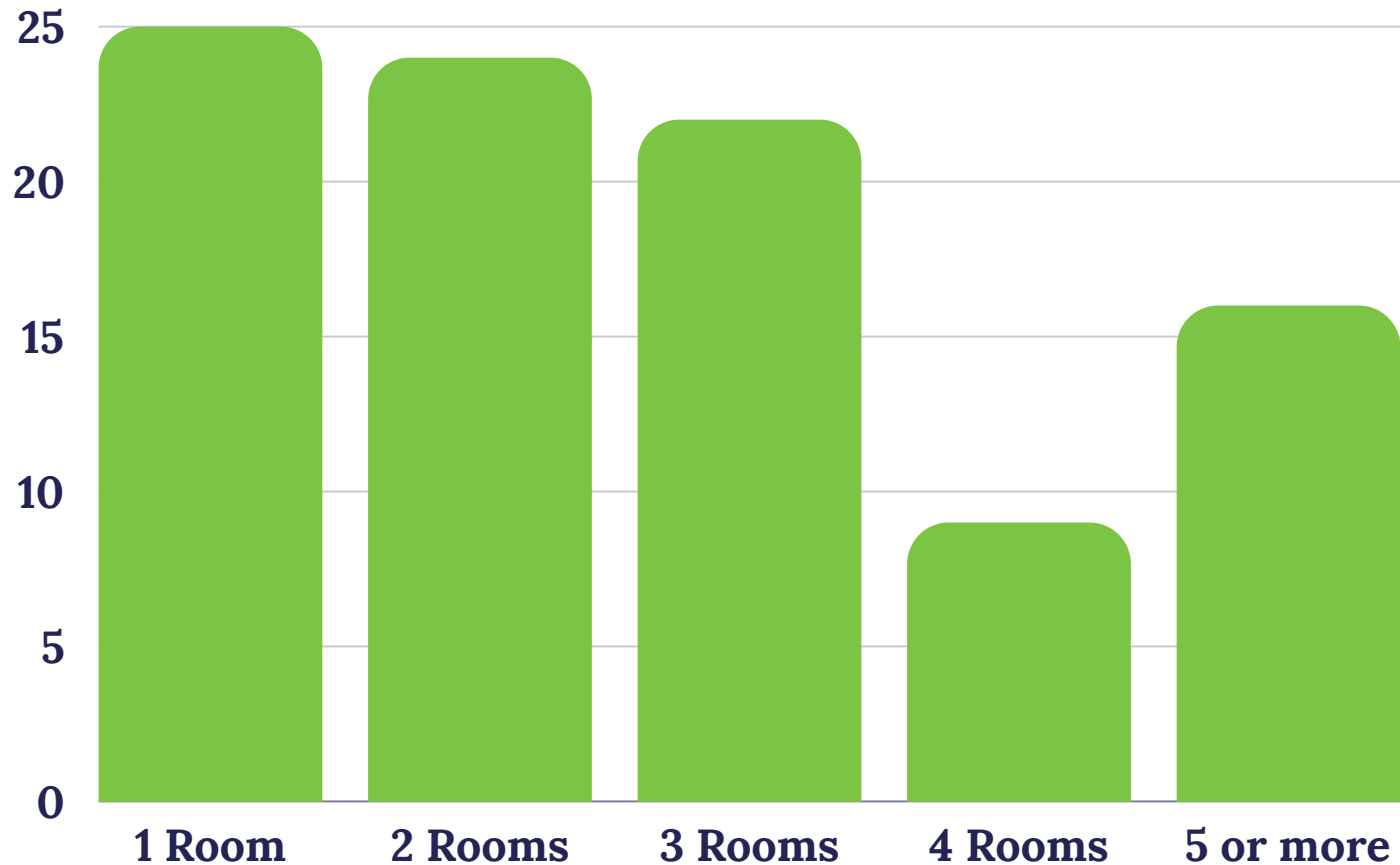

DEMONSTRATES THE PERCENTAGE OF ANESTHESIA PROVIDERS EMPLOYED VS CONTRACTED



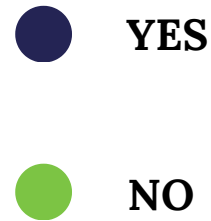
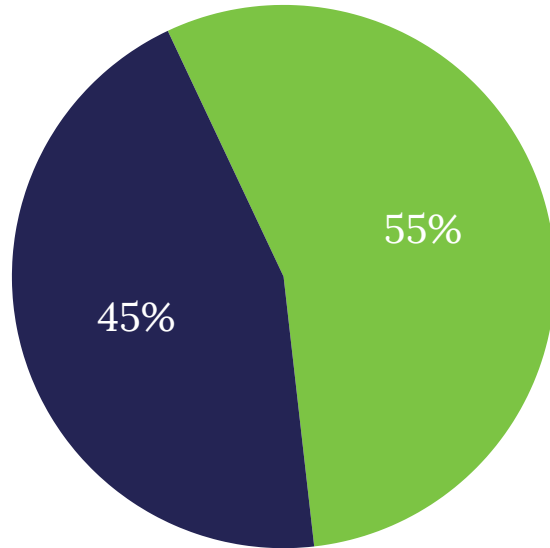
NUMBER OF ASC OR/PROCEDURE ROOMS



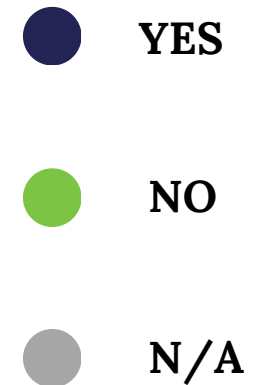
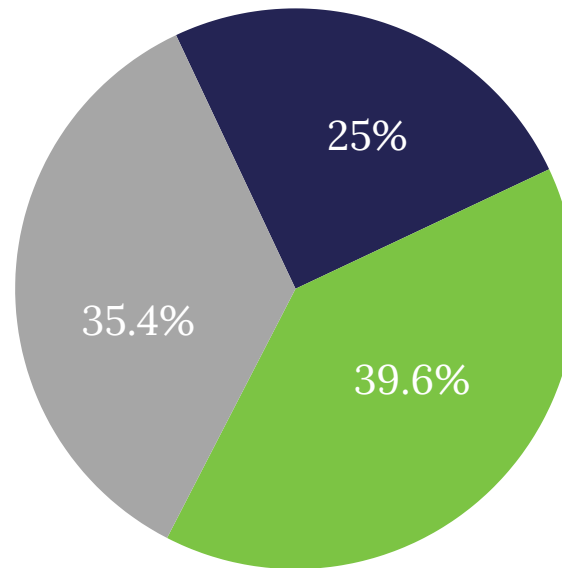

RATE OF ANESTHESIA SHORTAGES EXPERIENCED

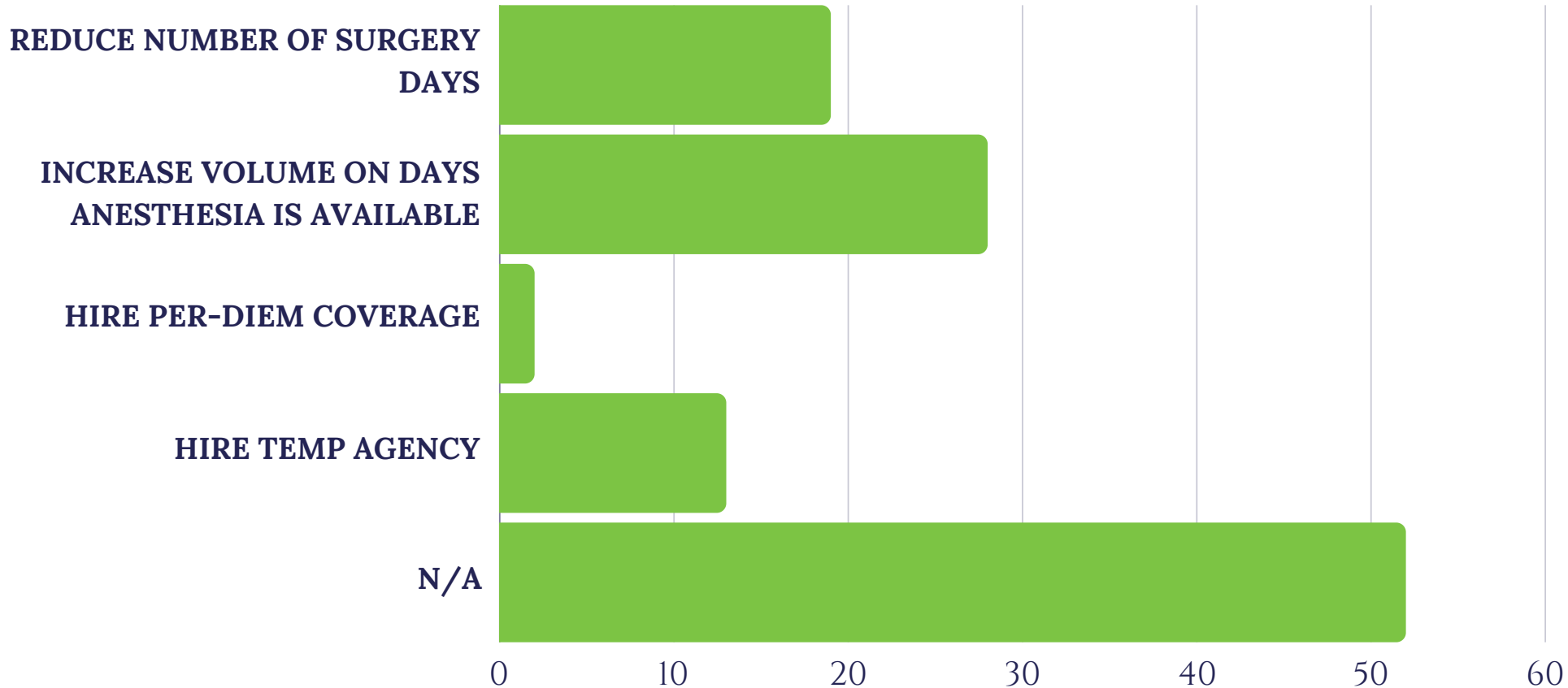

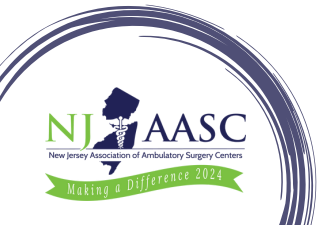

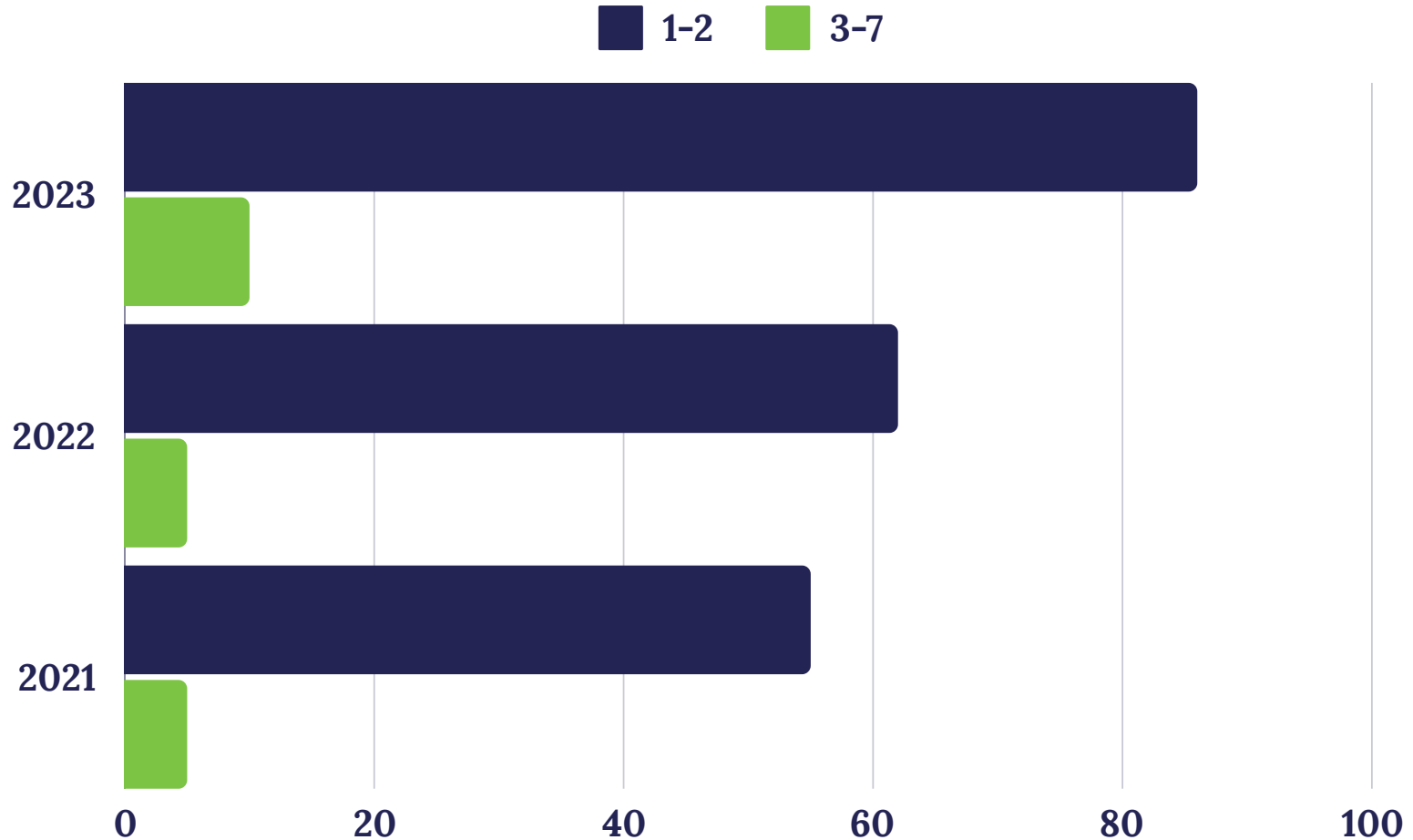
2023 OPERATIONAL MEASURES TO ADDRESS SHORTAGES

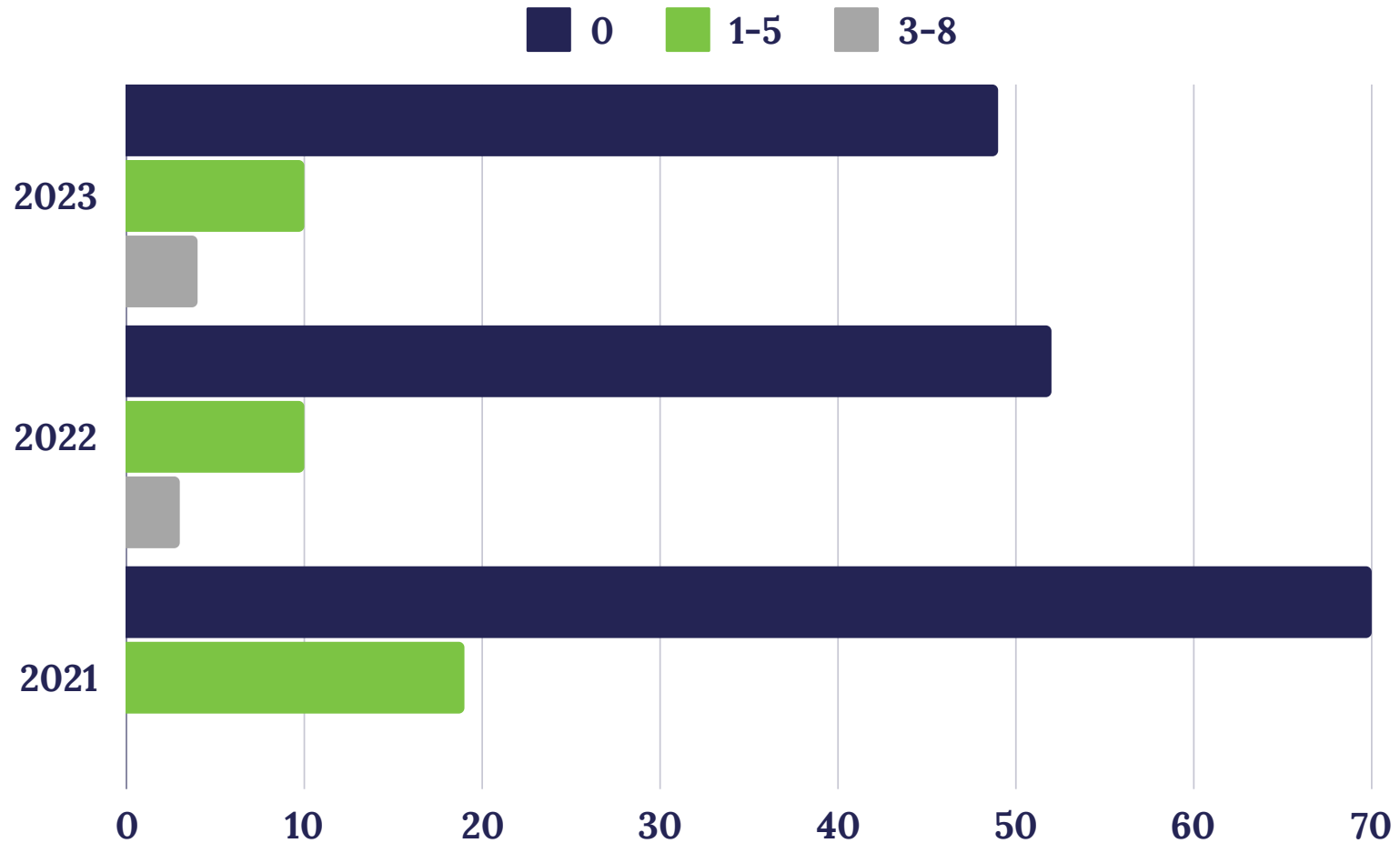
NUMBER OF ANESTHESIOLOGISTS SCHEDULED PER AVERAGE DAY

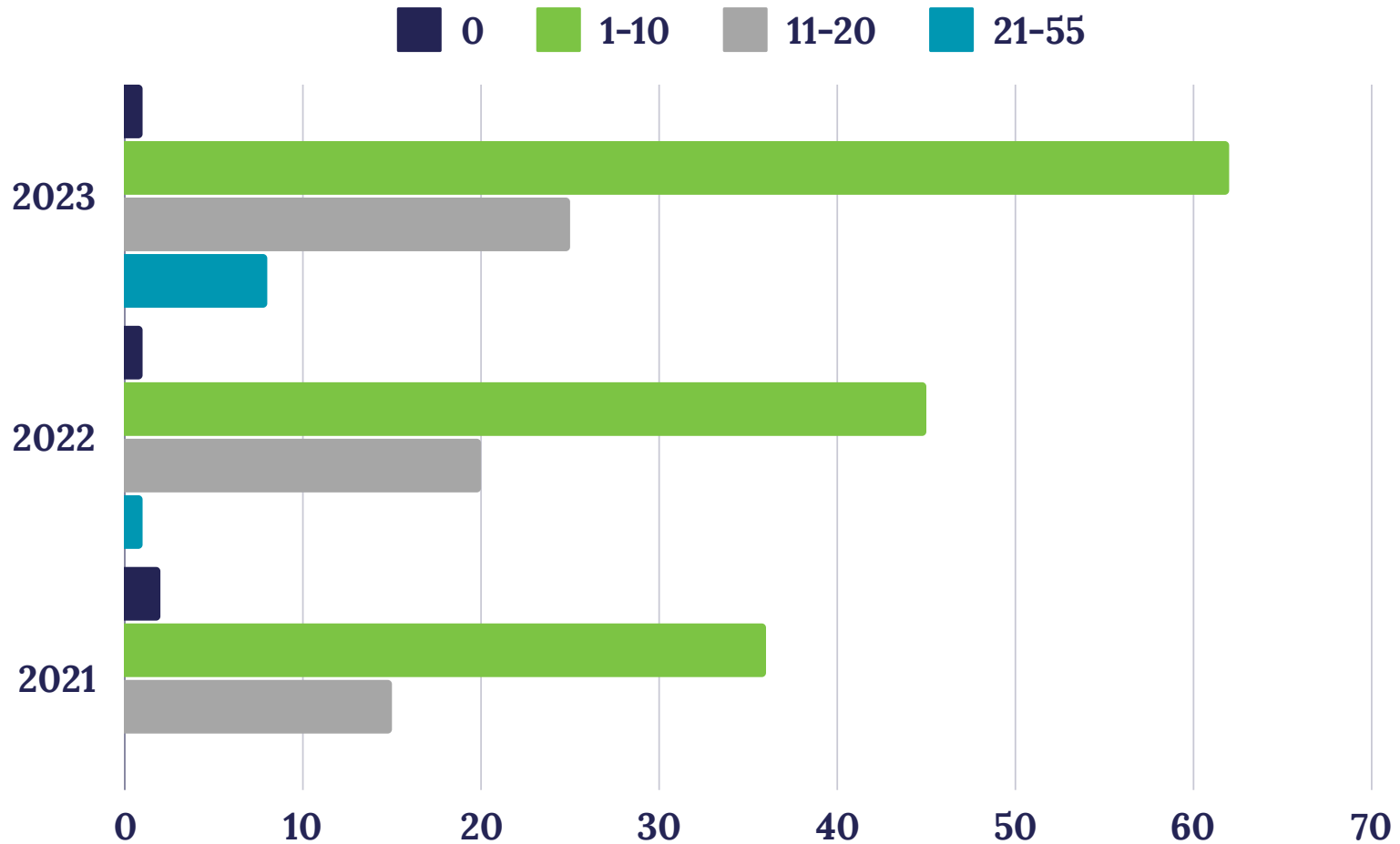
NUMBER OF CRNAS SCHEDULED PER AVERAGE DAY

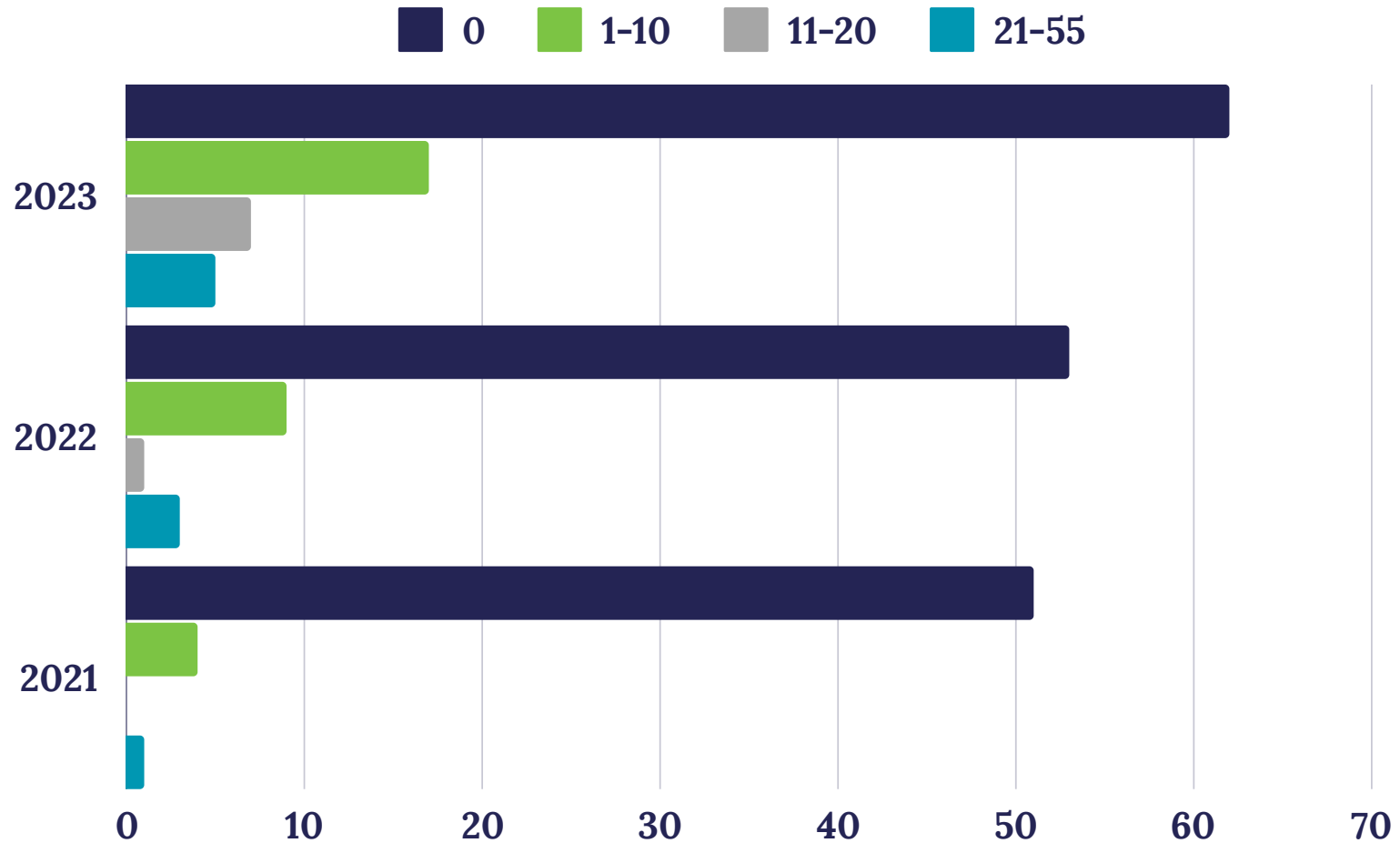
NUMBER OF CREDENTIALLED ANESTHESIOLOGISTS

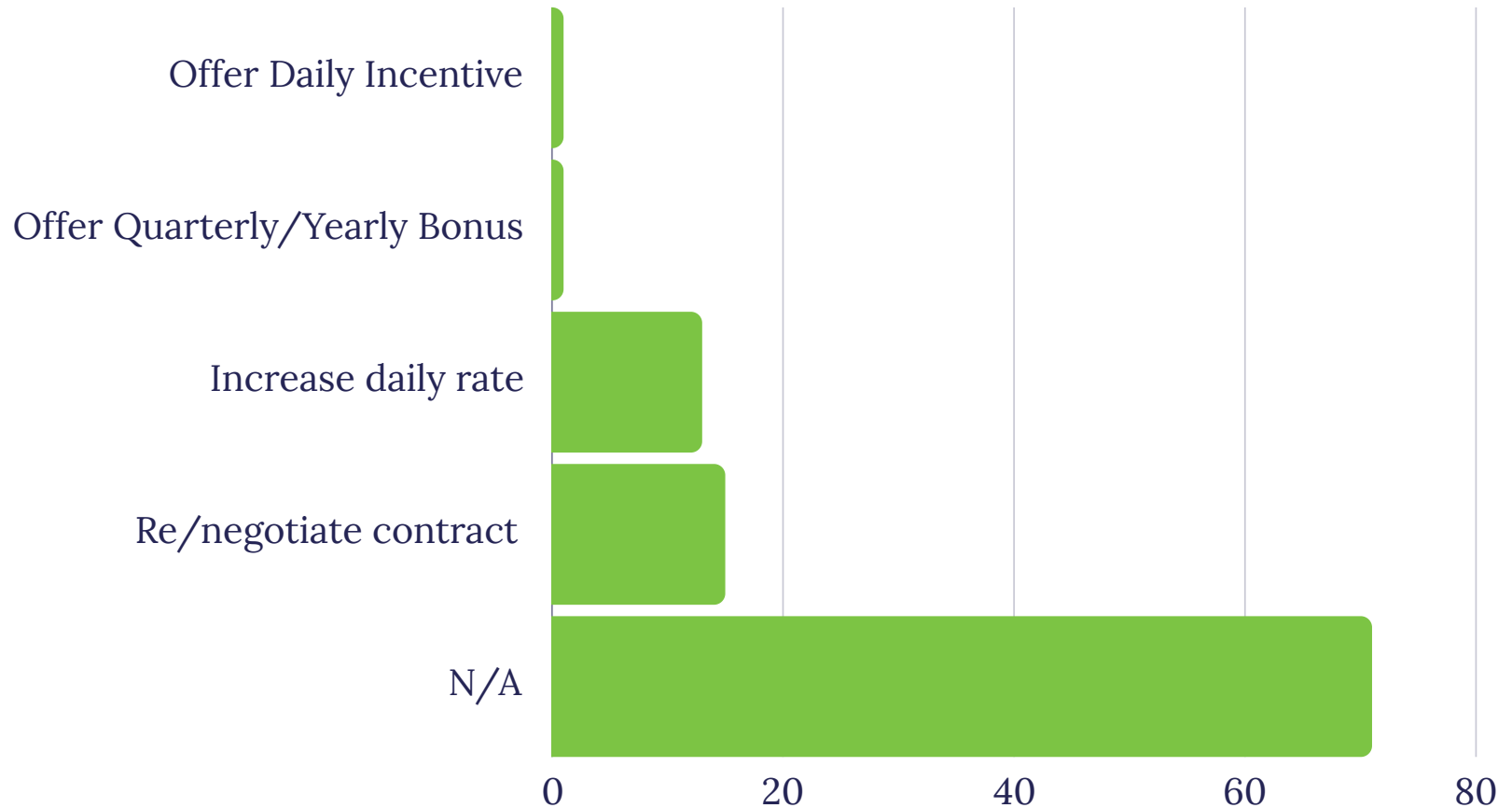
NUMBER OF CREDENTIALIAED CRNAS

PER ASC FOR 2021, 2022, AND 2023



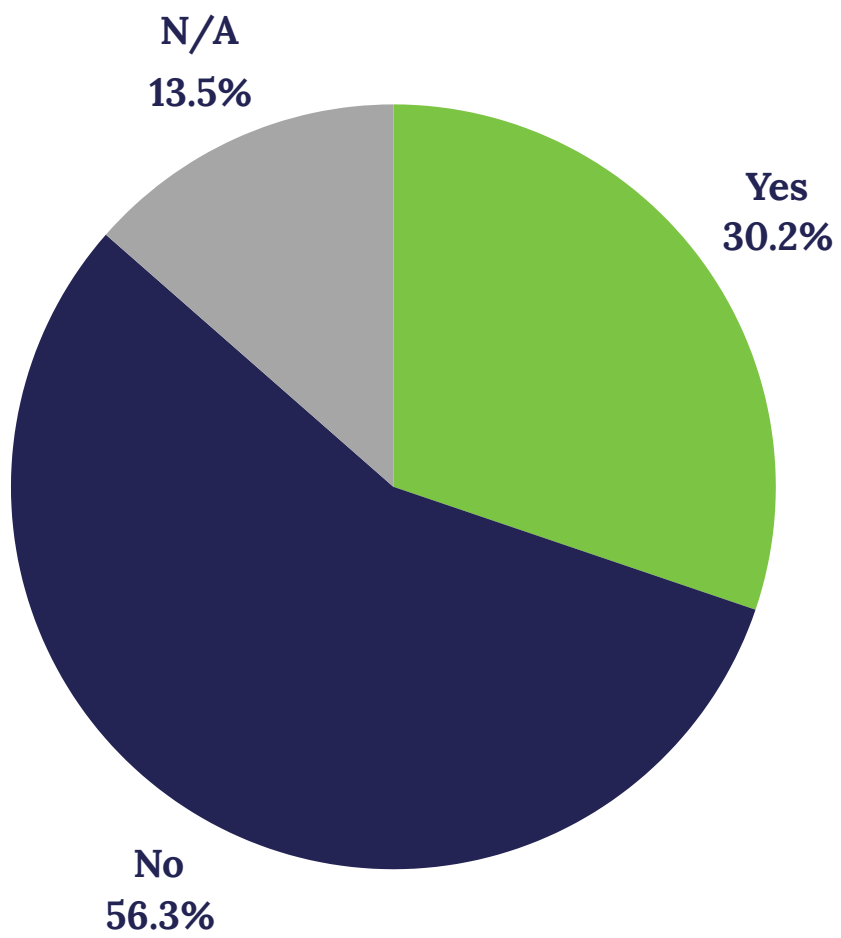
2023 ENTICEMENT MEASURES TO ADDRESS SHORTAGES

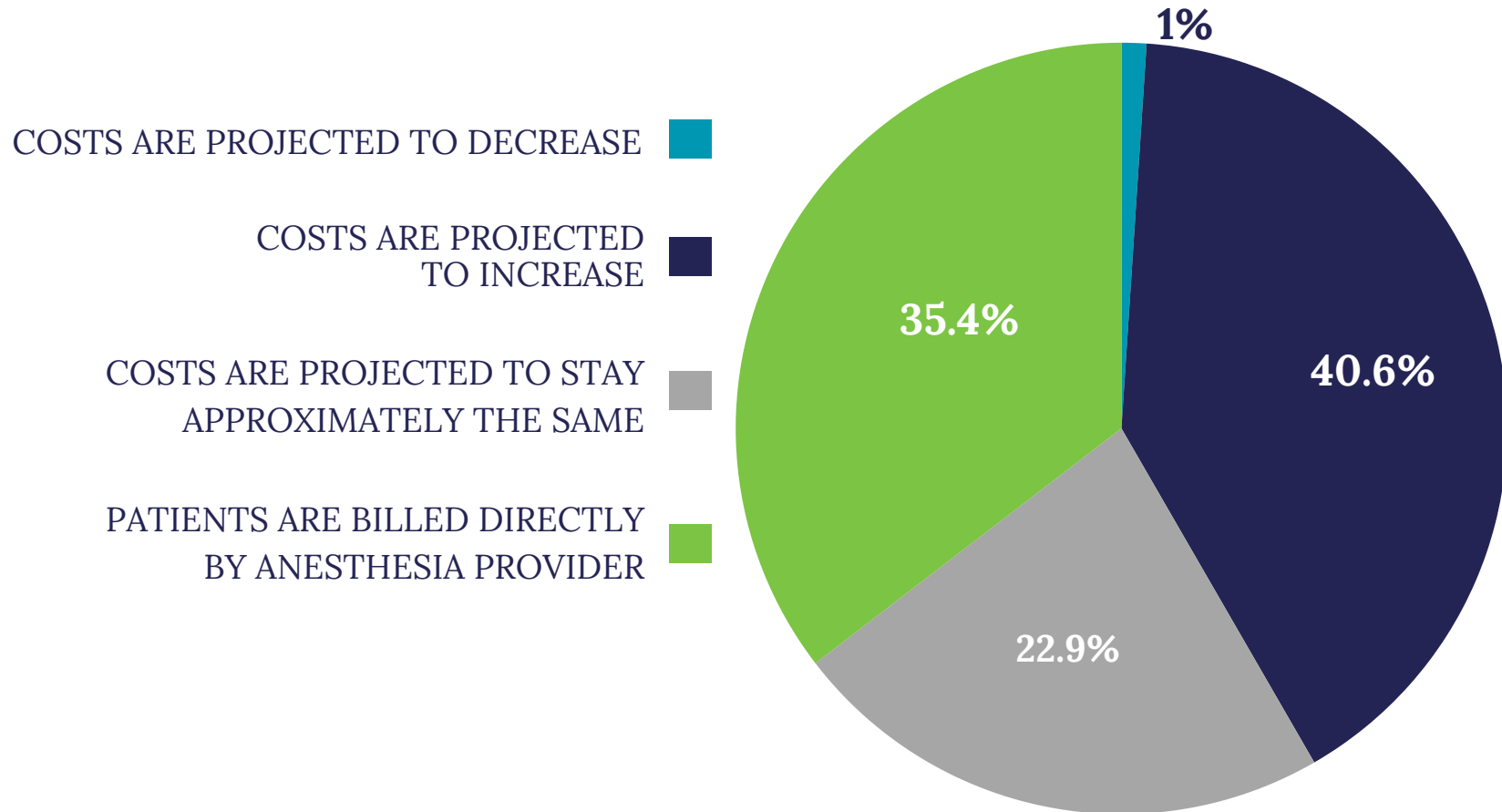
ANESTHESIA PROVIDER CONTRACTS RE-NEGOTIATED



PERCENTAGE RATE OF ANESTHESIA PROVIDER CONTRACTS RE-NEGOTIATED IN THE PAST YEAR



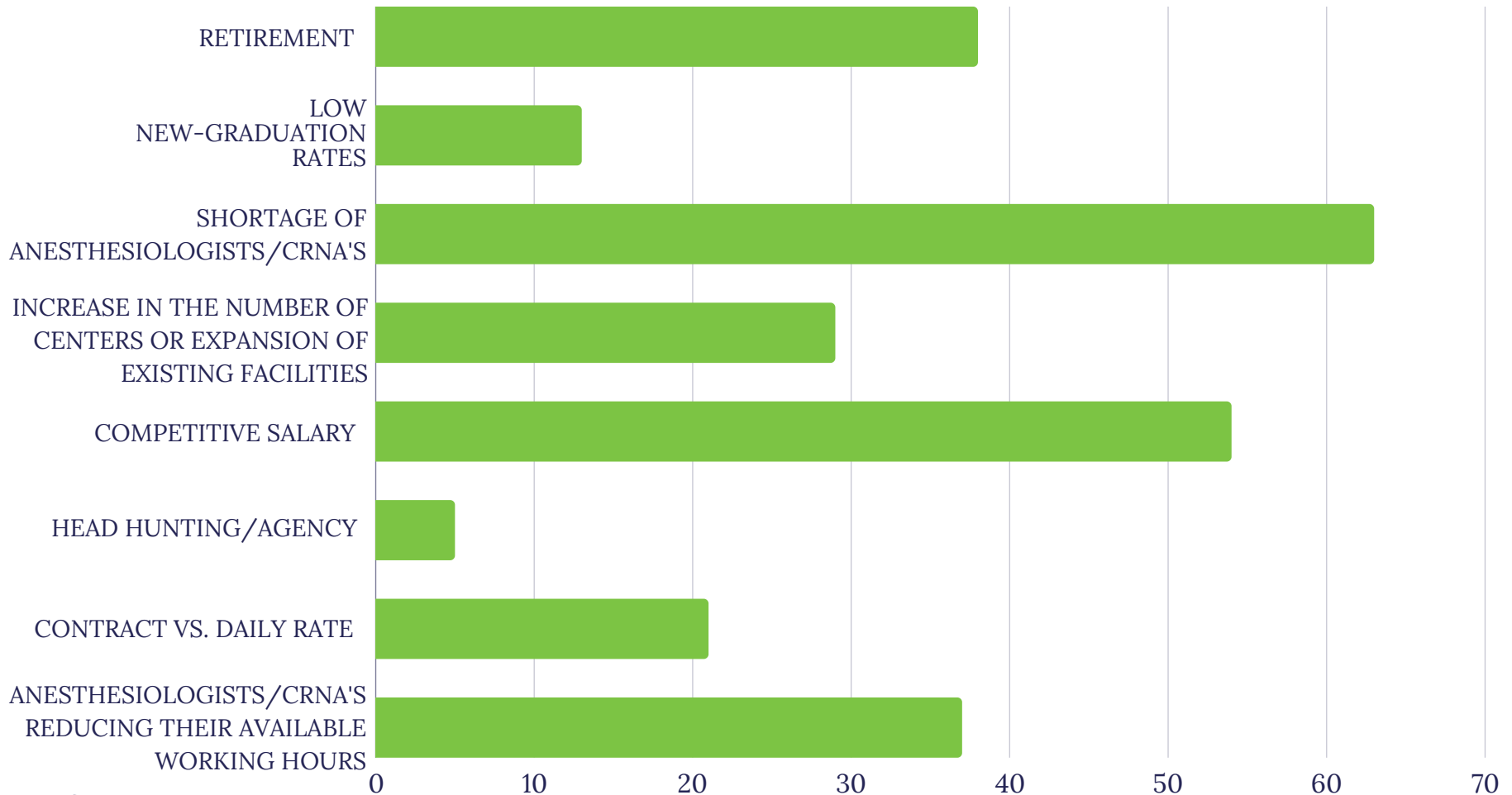
PROJECTED ANESTHESIA COSTS FOR 2024
