Quality of submission

• NAP process

 Quick response times from providers to completeness questions

Complete description in project narratives



Medicare Certified facilities are required to submit an CMS-855 Medicare Enrollment Application for changes in ownership (CHOW)

Delays in approved 855s could delay issues of amended licenses



Facilities Cease Operations

- If already licensed, contact us
- DOH can issue a letter that will give a MAX of two years to remain inactive but still licensed
- If CMS certified, CMS may terminate the provider agreement sooner than two years



Adding Services

- We do not approve the specific procedures
- The ASC can only perform the procedures/surgeries to the level of anesthesia that is approved on the license, and perform only those surgeries that do not require to be conducted in a general acute care hospital
- If the surgeries performed require a higher level of anesthesia than the ASC is licensed to provide, then at this time, the facility needs to come to the Department for review and prior approval to increase the level of anesthesia on their license



Closing of an ASC that opened as JV

As per N.J. Stat. § 26:2H-12 an ASC established as a JV was permitted to be licensed only because it was jointly owned by a hospital. If the hospital withdraws, the ASC should no longer be licensed or it could seek license by other means permitted in the law



Update on Current DOH CN&L Initiatives

Update on Registered Surgical Practices to ASCs

- New practices cannot be registered
- RSPs were required to apply for licensure No new applications can be accepted
- Review remaining applications of those still not licensed



Executive Directives

20-016 remains in effect

- Follow CDC and CMS
- Four counties have high COVID-19 Hospitalizations greater than 20 New COVID-19 Hospital Admissions per 100,000 population



Health Care Professional Responsibility and Reporting Enhancement Act

All health care entities must be in compliance with 8:30 Health care entities shall:

Notify the Clearinghouse Coordinator

Use the required form to notify the Coordinator

Cooperate with requests for information by the Division, a board, or the Medical Review Panel

Execute a joint report to the Coordinator with a healthcare professional



Health Care Professional Responsibility and Reporting Enhancement Act

- The Health Care Facility Inquiry Regarding Health Care Professional or CN-9 is available on the <u>NJ</u> <u>DOH website</u>.
- Maintain records of occurrence that triggered the creation of the report to the Clearinghouse
- CMPs may be issued for failing to report, retain records, cooperate with a request for information
